Minutes – August 15, 2012

The meeting was called to order by Ken Knight at the Library at 7:08 pm. Board members present were Ken Knight (President), Jay Ardai, Kris Minster, Amy Emerson, and Rachel Karn. Kathy Bailey was excused. Sally Otis was also present.

REPORTS:

<u>Librarian:</u> Sally updated us on a meeting she had attended about sustainable funding solutions, and current information about the ballot for funding on the school budget and the tax cap, and the need to file every year. There was also information presented about innovations in reaching out to the community, emphasizing that a public library is a public service, determining the "power people" in the area, and the importance of connecting with members of the community. Polaris has increased fees for service. There is a Law Book Collection now available from Seymour Library. Scott Gross sent a letter thanking the many people who helped with the Book Sale. Kevin Baylor is now head of SCCS school maintenance.

<u>Treasurer:</u> Jay presented the report, approved (Kris Minster/Rachel Karn). The final total from the Book Sale was \$3596.48.

OLD BUSINESS:

Book Sale: updates and recommendations for next year: Some changes were suggested for advertising next year, involving sizes and the information included at different dates. No text books, Reader's Digest Condensed books, etc will be taken. And it is preferred that we do not take the books left over from Aurora's book sale. Also discussed were different groups that might be approached to help with moving the books next year

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Sally presented a brief, but informative history of the Book Sale, (started in 1981) that was enjoyed by all.
